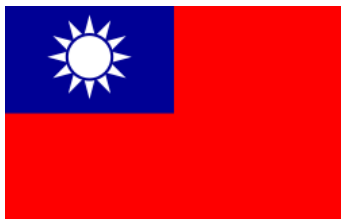
Republic of Upper Volta, now known as Burkina Foso, is a landlocked West African country established Dec. 11, 1958 as a self-governing colony within the French community.
